

NCLEX Pass Rates

Approved nursing programs must maintain an NCLEX pass rate of at least 80 percent of graduates taking the exam for the first time. Pass rates are measured for the period of October 1-September 30 of the following year. Schools failing to meet this requirement fall under the regulatory jurisdiction of the Rhode Island Board of Nurse Registration and Nursing Education.
